Resolve Foundation is a Hong Kong-based NGO that empowers future community leaders for an inclusive Hong Kong. Resolve stands for Rights, Equality, Solidarity, Organization, Leadership and Empowerment.

It was founded in 2017 with one question in mind: in an age of increasing polarization and intolerance, how can we build more inclusive and accepting societies?

Resolve believes the answer rests with communities themselves, harnessing their own power to bring about positive social change.

Through a social justice fellowship that triangulates leadership development, campaigning skills and human rights education, Resolve provides a supportive and enabling platform to amplify the voices of marginalized and underrepresented groups in Hong Kong.

The 8-month fellowship focuses on a different theme each year to promote grassroots leadership on social issues that deserve more attention.
